Meal Plan Requirement: All residence hall students must select a meal plan provided by Bon Appétit, the University food service provider. Please see Paragraph IV of the *2009-2010 Student Housing License Agreement*. The student agrees to pay for meal charges as indicated:

Meal Plan Guidelines:

1. The meal plan entitles the student to any meal beginning with Monday breakfast and ending with Sunday dinner.
2. No refunds will be given for meals not used on a weekly basis or flex dollars unused at the end of the semester.
3. Students on the meal plan are entitled to utilize only one meal during any single meal period. Flex dollars may be used any time Woody's Café is open.
4. Meals plans begin with brunch on Sunday, August 23, 2009, and end with dinner on Friday, May 7, 2010.
5. Meal plans are not available during Thanksgiving Break (breakfast Thursday, November 26, 2009 through brunch Sunday, November 29, 2009; meals resume at dinner Sunday, November 29, 2009) and Winter Break (dinner Saturday, December 12, 2009 through brunch Sunday, January 10, 2010; meals resume at dinner Sunday, January 10, 2010).
6. Woody's Café will be open during Spring Break, but only flex dollars may be used during that time.
7. Meal plans may be changed during the first week of the semester only. Students may change their meal plan one time only.
8. Student's termination of his/her meal plan agreement after the first week of the semester but prior to the ninth week of his/her total semester will result in a food service charge of 15% of his/her total semester meal plan charge plus a prorated charge for meals served through date of termination. Students who terminate the meal plan agreement on or after the ninth week of the semester will be responsible for the total semester meal plan charge.
9. Medical exceptions to the meal plan will be determined on a case-by-case basis by the Coordinator of Residential Communities.
